

Now Taking Off Successfully

Located away from the congestion of metropolitan airspace in the northwestern part of Pinal County, the **Ak-Chin Regional Airport** is a gateway to points throughout central and southern Arizona. Formerly known as Phoenix Regional Airport, this general aviation airport is conveniently situated between the cities of Maricopa and Casa Grande, just 44 miles southeast of Phoenix and 82 miles northwest of Tucson.



Owned and operated by the Ak-Chin Indian Community, the airport has undergone a series of renovations to improve its utility and safety. Additional improvements are planned and with the airport's acceptance into the National Plan of Integrated Airport Systems (NPIAS), it is eligible to receive Federal grants under the Airport Improvement Program (AIP).

The majority of the aircraft now utilizing the airport are predominately single engine and multi-engine piston aircraft. Other users also include rotorcraft, gliders, and ultralights. Existing users include flight training, business, and personal transportation along with recreational operations. Currently, the airport has space for 12 tiedowns. Planned expansion of the apron will accommodate additional tiedowns and eventually, t-shades and t-hangars.

With Ak-Chin's commitment to proper design, thoughtful development, and planned improvements, the airport is poised to help you take off successfully.

Land Great Lease Rates

The Ak-Chin Indian Community offers both on and off-airport leasing opportunities for pilots and businesses, including **Santa Cruz Commerce Center**, which is just five minutes from the airport. The Commerce Center, which is



already a part of Ak-Chin reservation land, offers shovel-ready lots with a build-to-suit option with substantial tax savings, low energy costs, and below market lease rates.

The former Phoenix Regional Airport was first constructed in 1999 and encompassed an area of approximately 406 acres, of which 270 acres are defined as the airport footprint. The airport was purchased by the Ak-Chin Indian Community in 2006 and was renamed in 2011. The airport and surrounding property owned by the Community now encompasses more than 450 acres.
